  - (ii) They shall come into force at once.
- 2. Application: These regulations shall apply to the recruitment to the posts of Assistant Welfare Commissioner under the West Bengal Labour Welfare Board (hereinafter referred to as the said posts). 2. 5.59/
- Method of recruitment: Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in any rules, notifications and orders for the time being in force, the recruitment to the said post under the West Bengal Labour Welfare Board shall be regulated in the following manner:
  - (a) By promotion from amongst the officers from the combined cadres of:
- (i) Head Clerk and Accountant and (ii) Inspectors-cum-Supervisor and Caretaker-cum-Storekeeper provided that the incumbents, who have rendered at least 6 (six) years continuous service in the combined cadre, shall be eligible for promotion.
  - (b) The rates of promotion from each of the combined cadres shall be 1:1.

- Short title and commencement: (i) These regulations may be called the West Bengal Labour Welfare Board Services (Recruitment of Deputy Welfare Commissioner) Regulations, 2001.
  - (ii) They shall come into force at once.
- Application: These regulations shall apply to the recruitment to the posts of Deputy Welfare Commissioner under the West Bengal Labour Welfare Board (hereinafter referred to as the said posts).
- 3. Method of and experience required for recruitment: Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in any rules, notifications and orders for the time being in force, the recruitment to the said post under the West Bengal Labour Welfare Board shall be regulated in the following manner:
- (i) By promotion from the post of Assistant Welfare Commissioner who has put preferably five years of continuous and satisfactory service in that post provided that not more than 35% (thirty-five percent) of the cadre shall be filled up by promotion.
- (ii) By deputation of officers whose names are borne in the West Bengal Labour Service or West Bengal Education Service (Social Education) and putting at least five years of service in the cadre.
- (iii) Desirable Experience (in case of deputation)— preferably five years in a responsible capacity in Labour or Social Education Administration.
